

VP - Softball

Overview: The Vice President of Softball is responsible for the oversight and overall direction of the WLL Softball program at all levels. The VP is also the liaison for Little League Softball between Wethersfield and the other participating towns in the District, as well as the representative for WLL softball when working with the Town of Wethersfield regarding fields, scheduling, etc. The VP of Softball is the Board of Directors member who is in charge of most aspects of the softball program.

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for monitoring registration numbers, coordinating and organizing team rosters and coaches, and providing roster and jersey information to the Uniform Representative at each level for each season.
- Implement, organize, and conduct tryouts/evaluations of players eligible to move up levels each spring.
- Coordinate All-Star softball tryouts/evaluations, establish team rosters, etc.
- Work in conjunction with the Softball Player Development representative regarding Winter Clinics, other clinics/improvements for the program, and collaborating with the Wethersfield High School softball coaches/program.
- Monitor interest in and encourage WLL Softball participation in the Memorial Day Parade.
- Attend a yearly Field Study with other critical Board members to present field issues and safety concerns to the town.
- Attend annual Parks and Recreation board meetings to be kept apprised of issues and voice league concerns.
- Organize and conduct coaches' training sessions.
- Attend yearly District meeting with other Softball Directors regarding the upcoming season's rules (at each level) and proposed game schedules.
- Maintain the connection between softball parents and the Board regarding concerns and questions throughout the year.
